Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we begin this new school year we are sending a quick reminder about which areas should and shouldn't be used for parking as well as picking up and dropping off students. We hope the attached map will be helpful in identifying these areas. If someone new is picking up your child, please make them aware of these guidelines as well.

Here are a few things to note:

- 1) If students are driven to school they should be dropped off by the sidewalk bordering the street in front of the school.
- 2) Cars should not be parked close to or in the bus entrance and exit areas. This can create dangerous situations for students and the bus.
- 3) Cars should not be parked in or close to the crosswalk on either side of the street.
- 4) If students ride their bikes to school they should ride them in the west driveway and place them in the bike racks and then use the sidewalk to access the school grounds. When leaving students should exit with their scooters, bikes, hoverboards, etc. out of the west driveway and then to the sidewalk and/or road.
- 5) When leaving school students are encouraged to cross in the painted crossing area in the front of the school to get to the sidewalk facing the street instead of just crossing in random places.

We appreciate your support in our efforts to help our students to be safe on their way to and from school daily.
